Tournament Format

Sandpaper Events

- Sandpaper bats will be provided for play.
- Matches will be the best of 3 games to 15 points, 2 serves alternating.
- Any games in which the score goes to 14-all will have a sudden death point.
- A double point ball can be played once during each match by each player.
- Open Sandpaper Event will be Round Robin groups (each 5 or 6 players); the top 4 players from each group proceed to the main knockout draw.
- If there is sufficient demand, there may be consolation and plate events for the Open Sandpaper.

Wood Events

- Bats must be 100% wood blade, no coating. Some wood bats will be available to borrow or buy on the day.
- Matches will be a race to 30 points, 2 serves alternating. Any matches in which the score goes to 29-all will have a sudden death point.
- Event will probably be Round Robin groups of 3, but may be straight knockout.

Qualifying Spots for PPWC 2025, January 2025, Mexico

- The Winner of the Open Wood will be awarded a guaranteed qualifying spot for Wood Open Singles at PPWC 2025.
- There are 3 guaranteed qualifying spots for Sandpaper Open Singles at PPWC 2025. These will be awarded to the Winner and Runner-Up of the Open Sandpaper, with the 3rd spot awarded at discretion of the Organisers.
- Players eliminated from the Open Sandpaper knockout stage by a prequalified player may join a Double Elimination stage.
- Depending on entries, additional qualifying spots may be awarded for any event - including Ladies', Students' and Veterans'. These will be awarded at discretion of the Organisers.
